25. Committees

(j) All committees of reference, as listed in (a) above, shall observe the following rules of procedure:

(1) (G) Consideration of measure required when motion is made out of order to report measure favorably. If a motion is made that a committee report a measure favorably to the committee of the whole, with or without amendments, when such measure is not in the order of business determined by the chairman pursuant to subparagraph (D) of this paragraph (1), then such measure shall be considered by the committee upon its merits. If such motion fails to pass, the measure shall be deemed to be still pending before the committee for action.
