COLORADO RIVER

(S. R. No. 79, by Senator Bannister)

AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CHANGE OF THE NAME OF THE GRAND RIVER TO THE COLORADO RIVER.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Grand river, named changed to Colorado Section 1. That the name of the Grand River in Colorado is hereby changed to the Colorado River, by which name said River shall hereafter be known, from its source to where it crosses the western boundary of the State of Colorado.

Effect

Section 2. The change of the name of said River shall in no wise affect the rights of this State, or of any County, Municipality, corporation, association or person; and all laws, records, surveys, maps and other public or private documents of every kind and nature in which the said River is mentioned or referred to under or by the name of the Grand River, shall hereafter refer to the same River and with the same purport and effect, under and by the name of the Colorado River.
