

CHAPTER 37

APPROPRIATION

RELIEF OF MRS. EDNA B. MULNIX

(H. B. No. 148, by Mr. Lake)

AN ACT

FOR THE RELIEF OF MRS. EDNA B. MULNIX, MOTHER OF HARRY O. MULNIX, DECEASED, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Appropriation

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in favor of Mrs. Edna B. Mulnix, mother of Harry O. Mulnix, a minor, eleven years of age, who was killed on June 22nd, 1920, by reason of being crushed by an elevator of the State Capitol Building, Denver, Colorado, which, at the time, was operated by an employee of the State of Colorado.

Purpose

Payment

Section 2. The Auditor of State is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of the said Mrs. Edna B. Mulnix, for the amount herein appropriated, out of the Capitol Building Fund, not otherwise appropriated, which sum when paid, shall be in full satisfaction and payment of any and all claims of the said Mrs. Edna B. Mulnix, for and on account of the death of her son, the said Harry O. Mulnix, or in any way connected therewith.

Section 3. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; therefore, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. ^{Emergency}
