AN ACT

RELATIVE TO THE TEACHING IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS
OF COLORADO OF THE HISTORY AND CIVIL GOV-
ERNMENT OF THE STATE OF COLORADO.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Teaching of
history and
civil government

Section 1. That the history and civil government of the State of Colorado shall be taught in all the public schools of this State.

Superintendent
of Public
Instruction
provide course
of study

Section 2. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall include in the State course of study the history and civil government of the State of Colorado.
