

On motion of Senator Leddy the report was adopted.

S. J. R. No. 14, by Senator Reuter, was read, as follows:

Whereas, There appears to be a shortage in the accounts of Albert Nance, late Treasurer of this State, as said Treasurer; be it

Resolved, By the Senate of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Attorney-General of the State of Colorado be and he is hereby required to bring suit against Albert Nance, late Treasurer of this State, and against his sureties upon his official bond for the sum of his deficiency in his official accounts as such Treasurer.

Senator Hartzell moved that the resolution be referred to the Finance Committee.

S. J. R. No. 15, by Senator Drake, was read as follows:

Be it Resolved, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Colorado, in view of the long and eminent services to the State of ex-Governor John Evans, and as a fitting recognition thereof, that the mountain situate in what is known as the "Platte Range," in section twenty-seven (27), township five (5) south, of range seventy-four (74) west, be, and the same hereby is named in honor of the ex-governor, and shall be hereafter known and designated as "Mount Evans."

Senator Drake moved that the resolution be adopted. Senator Moody moved that the resolution be referred to the Committee on Railroads and Corporations. Senator Moody's motion was not agreed to. Senator Barela moved as an amendment that the resolution be adopted by a rising vote, which was unanimously agreed to.

On motion of Senator Barela S. B. No. 159 was made a special order for 2 o'clock p. m., to-day.

Senator Barela's resolution of a previous day was read as follows:

Resolved, That M. C. Hayes be, and he is hereby declared elected Assistant Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate, to take effect from and after February 6, 1895.

Senator Barela moved that the resolution be adopted. Senator Mills moved that "Assistant Doorkeeper" be inserted instead of "Assistant Sergeant-at-Arms." The amendment was not agreed to. Senator Leddy moved that the further consid-
